

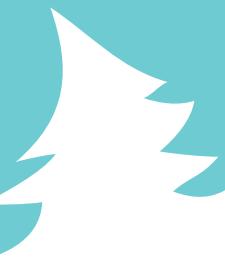

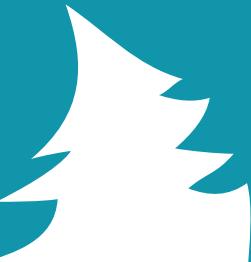

Sandwiches, juice, cheese, etc. (Let the children suggest what they want)




